The format of this clinic will be a 30 minute session – you will ride your test, receive feedback and training advice from Dottie, and then ride your test again. You will receive your scoring sheets from each ride so that you can reference them in the future. Dress is casual but an ASTM helmet is required.

Dottie Morkis was the anchor of the U.S. Team at the 1976 Olympics and the very last rider to go in the team competition. She was responsible for the placing of the American team's Bronze medal and despite riding first, Dottie placed fifth individually in the Grand Prix Special. In addition, Dottie is also a Pan Am Gold and Bronze medalist. Currently, Dottie is competing with Mr. Big and her young horse, Artiest and trains with Rien van der Schaft.

When she is not competing and training her own horses, Dottie offers classical dressage training instruction to all levels of riders and horses. She is based out of White Horse Farm in Dover, Massachusetts.
